

Getting to Burghley House

Burghley is situated one mile from Stamford, 20 minutes by car north of Peterborough

By Car:

There are a number of junctions on the A1 giving access to Stamford, but the most convenient for access to Burghley is the roundabout to the south of the town, following the road past the Burghley Estate wall. Just past the A43 on the left, turn right past the Bull and Swan Public House and continue for one mile along the Barnack Road. The visitors entrance is on the right. From Peterborough either use the above route after driving to the A1 on one of the routes out of the city, or follow a more rural route via Marholm, Ufford, and Barnack.
